

Crosshatch Value Scale Worksheet

Start by using crosshatching to shade Value 9, as demonstrated below. Then crosshatch a different direction for Value 8, but covering the rectangle for both Value 8 AND Value 9. Next, shade the rectangles for Value 7, 8, and 9. Each layer of crosshatching makes the previous layer one value darker! Do this for all the values except Value 1. Why? Because Value 1 is white- i.e., your paper. Practice below using different pencil grades and media (try using a pen, or a marker, too). Feel free to print extra copies.
